



**Faculty of Pharmacy, Thammasat University Announcement**

**Subject: Recruitment for University Staff Position - Academic Track**

**Position: Researcher (Practitioner Level), Faculty of Pharmacy, Round 1/2569**

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The Faculty of Pharmacy, Thammasat University, invites applications for the recruitment and selection of university staff in the academic track, with details as follows:

**1. Position Available**

1.1 Researcher (Practitioner Level) - PhD qualification required: 2 position

1.2 Salary: 41,000 Baht

**2. Position Requirements**

2.1 Successful candidates selected by the Faculty of Pharmacy as a Researcher will be appointed upon approval by the Dean of the Faculty of Pharmacy.

2.2 Selected candidates must be able to work at Thammasat University, Rangsit Center, Pathum Thani Province.

2.3 For government scholarship recipients currently fulfilling their scholarship obligations, if selected, they must obtain written consent from their institution and funding source to transfer their scholarship service location.

**3. Qualifications of Eligible Applicants**

**3.1 General Qualifications**

3.1.1 Must hold a degree in a field that directly relates to or is relevant to the assigned research area.

3.1.2 Must have a thesis or practical work experience in the academic field for which research will be assigned.

3.1.3 Must have completed a degree from a curriculum accredited by the Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation (MHESI), or the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), or the Civil Service Commission of Higher Education Institutions (CSC-HEI).

3.1.4 Male applicants must have been exempted from military conscription or have completed military service.

### 3.2 Position-Specific Qualifications

Must hold a PhD degree in Pharmaceutical Sciences or other related fields.

### 3.3 Foreign Language Proficiency Requirements

3.3.1 Applicants must achieve a minimum score on one of the following foreign language proficiency tests as specified in the table:

#### **Type of Test Minimum Score Required**

##### 1. TOEFL

- Paper Based (out of 667) 550
- Computer (out of 300) 213
- Internet Based (out of 120) 79

##### 2. IELTS (out of 9) 6.5

##### 3. TU-GET (out of 1,000) 550

##### 4. CU-TEP (out of 120) 75

Foreign language test results as specified in the table must not be longer than 2 years from the application date or selection date.

3.3.2 Applicants with the following qualifications may be exempted from presenting foreign language test scores as specified in the table:

3.3.2.1 Graduated from an international program or a program taught in English, Chinese, or other languages as specified by the Faculty, where such programs are accredited by the Office of the Permanent Secretary, MHESI, or OCSC, or CSC-HEI.

3.3.2.2 Foreign applicants who demonstrate very good proficiency in using English for communication.

3.3.2.3 In cases where selected candidates have foreign language test results according to Section 3.3.1, but the Faculty preliminarily considers that the candidate has foreign language proficiency at a level likely to achieve scores not lower than those specified in the table in Section 3.3.1, the Faculty may propose to the Screening Committee for approval of the appointment on a case-by-case basis. If the Screening Committee agrees with the Faculty's proposal, it may recommend approval for the appointment and employment of such selected candidate, subject to the condition that the candidate must

take a foreign language proficiency test and achieve scores not lower than those specified in Section 3.3.1, or pass two graduate-level English courses: TU005 (English 1) and TU006 (English 2), or complete the English language training program for doctoral graduates offered by the Language Institute, Thammasat University. Failure to take the test or achieving scores lower than the specified criteria in the table in Section 3.3.1, or failing to pass both English courses, or failing to complete the English language training within one year from the date of appointment shall result in termination of employment as university staff.

#### **4. Application Procedure**

4.2 Send the application form by post to: Faculty of Pharmacy, 6th Floor, Learning and Laboratory Building, Thammasat University, Rangsit Center, 99 Moo 18, Khlong Nueng, Khlong Luang, Pathum Thani 12121. The Faculty will only consider applications and supporting documents received by February 16, 2569 (2026).

##### **4.4 Documents Required with Application:**

(1) Copies of degree certificates and transcripts (original documents must be presented for verification). For documents not in Thai or English, applicants must provide certified Thai or English translations. For degrees from foreign institutions using grading systems without GPA, applicants must prepare a GPA equivalency statement with explanations and supporting evidence.

(2) Certificate of academic achievement from the council of the institution as specified in the position-specific qualifications.

(3) Copies of household registration and national ID card, 1 set (original documents must be presented for verification).

(4) Copies of documents evidencing changes in title, first name, or surname (if applicable).

(5) Copies of documents evidencing military service exemption or completion, 1 set (for male applicants only).

(6) Recent photograph (full face, without hat or sunglasses), size 1 or 2 inches, taken within 1 year (from application closing date), 1 photo.

(7) Medical certificate (not older than 6 months) must specify the following diseases:

(7.1) Active tuberculosis

(7.2) Elephantiasis with socially unacceptable symptoms

(7.3) Narcotic drug addiction

(7.4) Chronic alcoholism

(7.5) Chronic kidney failure

(7.6) Dementia

(7.7) Psychiatric disorders with prominent or severe symptoms that impede work performance

(7.8) Serious infectious diseases or chronic diseases with prominent or severe symptoms that impede work performance as specified by OCSC

## 5. Selection Criteria and Methods

5.1 Psychological Testing Applicants must undergo mental health screening at the Social Services Unit, Faculty of Medicine, Thammasat University, Rangsit Center. Normal mental health results are required to report for duty.

5.2 Emotional Intelligence Testing Applicants must undergo emotional intelligence testing at Thammasat University Hospital, Thammasat University, Rangsit Center. Results must demonstrate characteristics suitable for work performance.


